If This Sin Can Be Forgiven, Any Sin Can Be Forgiven Acts 2:14-41

Today we begin a short three week series entitled Salvation 101. What is salvation, and why is it essential to understanding life? And why does this matter if you're already saved?

Salvation? From what? What's the problem exactly?

The Sin

- "God has made him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified." (Acts 2:36)
 - o It doesn't get much worse than this!
- Response: "They were cut to the heart... 'What shall we do?'" (Acts 2:37)

Salvation!

- "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins..."
 - o The *core* of salvation is forgiveness of sins (Jer 31:34; Matt 6:14-15, 26:28; Mark 2:5; Acts 10:43, 13:38, etc.)
 - What's your worst sin? It's forgivable.
 - o For Christians: if you're unfruitful and "stuck," you might have forgotten something... See 2 Peter 1:8-9.
- But forgiveness is not *everything* that salvation is! There's much more. Here are three items:
 - o Last week we talked about **everlasting life** (John 10:27-28)

- Peter also proclaimed the gift of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:38; the gift of internal renovation!)
- We are **adopted** as children of God (Gal 4:5, Rom 8:15, Eph 1:5)

Peter gives us three things to do:

- 1. Repent (= change your mind about how you live your life and turn toward God, Acts 2:38)
 - o Repentance and faith are two sides of the same coin.
- 2. Be baptized (if you haven't been already; Acts 2:38)
- 3. Watch out for deadly influences
 - o "Save yourselves from this crooked generation" (Acts 2:40)
 - Surprisingly strong language!
 - It wasn't just that generation, but this is a perennial problem (Deut 32:5; Matt 24:12-13; Luke 21:34; John 15:19; Rom 12:2; James 4:4; 1 John 2:15-17; Rev 18:4)

Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. Do you have a favorite Bible verse that summarizes salvation? What is it?
- 2. Read Acts 2:14-41. Note the importance of forgiveness of sins! And what Peter tells the people to do.
 - a. Have you done these things?
 - b. Are you doing these things? Discuss and pray.
- 3. Advanced question. Discuss this statement overheard at a church: "Of course I'm saved, but let's move on from that basic stuff and get to the *meat*."
 - a. Could this be a worrisome statement? See 2 Peter 1:8-9.
 - b. Consider also Hebrews 5:12-14 and 1 Cor 3:1-4.
