ROOMS FOR PARENTS AND THEIR CHILDREN

Children are welcome to worship with us, but in case they're needed we have:

A Nursery— for infants and toddlers (ground floor, room G10) during both services

New Mothers' Room— for Moms with babies who are still nursing or taking regular bottles. Exit the rear doors of the Sanctuary and turn right. There is a changing table in there as well. Knock before entering.

Family Room— for Dads with babies or parents who want to continue to practice sitting through the service via livestream with their children. Exit the rear Sanctuary doors, go down the hall to room 108.
