1. Everything that God has made shows you something of who he is.
 - a. Can you think of a time when you looked past something in the physical, visible world and saw something of the God who made it?
 - b. How did seeing that about him help you love and worship him better?
 - c. How often do people help you see God's glory even more than the inanimate creation does?
2. God shows you his glory as he:
 - a. Orders and rules his world,
 - i. Where do you more easily embrace his ordering? Where do you resist how he's set the world up?
 - b. Calls for life to come spilling out of his world,
 - i. What kinds of life (vegetative, animal, human) do you find yourself more drawn to? Which kinds do you value less than God does? In what ways do you see yourself doing that?
 - c. Provides everything that's needed to nurture physical and spiritual life.
 - i. Where do you find yourself gratefully taking in God's provision of food and his word? Where do you struggle to do so?
3. How are you giving yourself to God's order, life and provision so that others might be able to see his glory better?
