Discussion Questions:

- 1. What's your relationship with God's justice?
 - a. Have you learned to embrace it or do you still struggle with it?
 - b. Which parts of his justice are easier and harder for you to accept?
 - c. How much does his justice move you to long for and celebrate his solution?
