"Atonement" means 'to wipe away' or 'to cover' the guilt of sin from God's eyes. This was accomplished by a blood sacrifice in the OT. The shedding of blood dramatizes the cost of forgiveness and points to the sacrificial death of Christ on the cross. ¹
